

# Intersection Sight Distance



*Kenmore is growing and changing! As our streets become more urban, on-street parking is increasing. It's not always easy to see oncoming traffic from side streets and driveways. The City of Kenmore offers the following suggestions for drivers.*

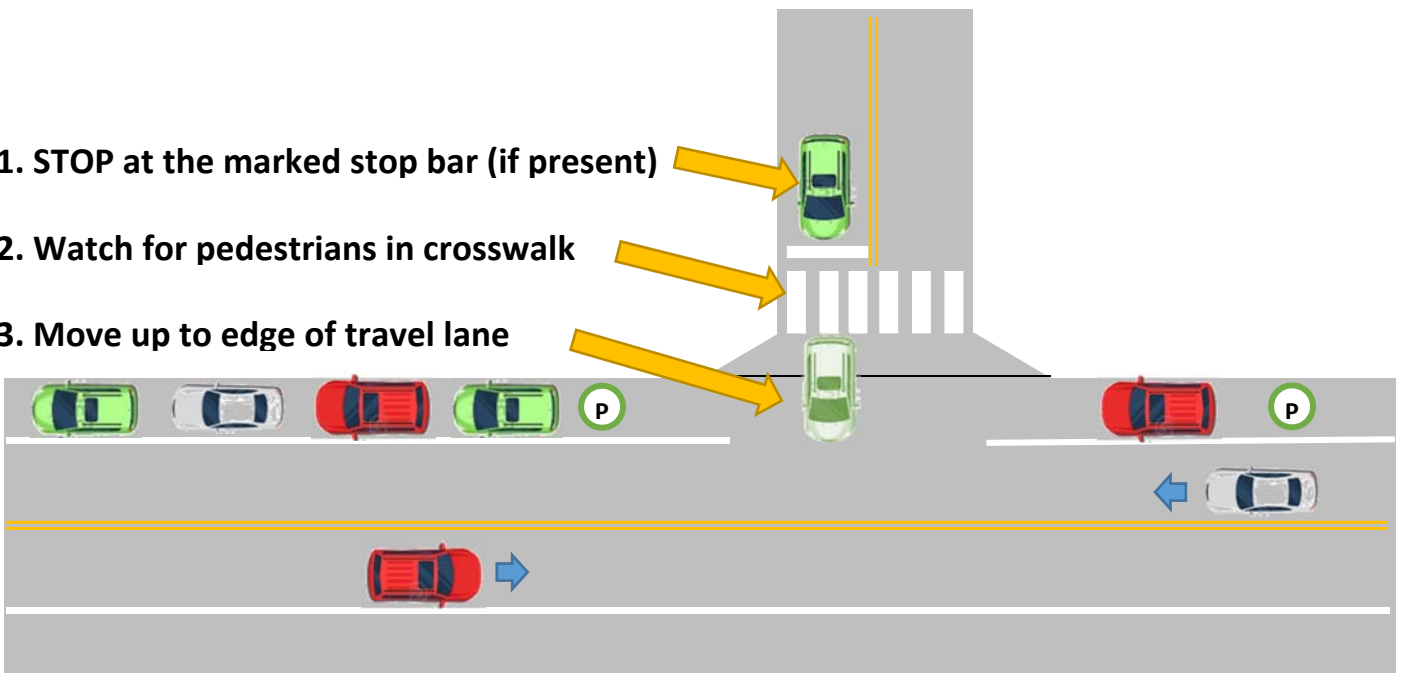


**Hank**

**1. STOP at the marked stop bar (if present)**

**2. Watch for pedestrians in crosswalk**

**3. Move up to edge of travel lane**



Drivers must stop at marked stop bars, but sight distance can be blocked by parked cars, street trees, fences and vegetation. It is acceptable for drivers to carefully move up, across crosswalks (yielding to pedestrians) and to the marked edge of the travel lane to see oncoming vehicles in either direction.
