To help protect our children, the City of Kenmore and the Kenmore Police Department are implementing an automated photo enforcement program which will use automated traffic safety cameras to enforce Kenmore's traffic laws governing speeding at marked school zones and those that govern red-light violations.

This Courtesy Warning Notice depicts your vehicle traveling above the posted speed limit in a school zone in violation of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 46.61.440 and Kenmore City Code Chapter 10.45, along with the date, time, and location of the violation.

- This is a courtesy warning only.
- There is no penalty.
- No response is needed.

However, after the warning period expires, a speed zone violation captured by automated cameras in Kenmore may result in a Notice of Infraction which carries up to a \$100.00 penalty. By state law, infractions detected through the use of automated safety cameras are not part of the registered owner's driving record.

We urge you to obey the speed limit in school zones. Speeding in school zones can have fatal consequences. We encourage you to discuss this information with anyone who drives your vehicle.
