SUBJECT: Comprehensive Plan and Development Regulation Amendment

A pplications

Each year the city's Comprehensive Plan and development regulations may be amended by the Kenmore City Council. To request consideration of a 2024 amendment, applications must be delivered, or postmarked and mailed, to the City of Kenmore no later than *December 1, 2023*. Please note that the City presently is working on its State-mandated Comprehensive Plan update and has limited resources to review private proposals. The City Council may deny or defer proposals as a result.

The attached information includes an application form (Form 901) and submittal checklist (Form 902). The pre-screening *I* threshold review fee is \$200.00. An applicant whose amendment proposal is approved by the City Council for consideration during the 2024 Amendment Process pursuant to KMC 19.20.060(D) shall pay an additional fee of \$400.00 to cover the cost of processing, review and analysis of their amendment proposal. A fee waiver request may be granted in the following cases: requests involving a topic of a city-wide nature; or a neighborhood wide request; a request made by a nonprofit organization when involving more than one property; or city-sponsored proposals. Fee waivers are not allowed for site-specific Comprehensive Plan land use amendments.

Applications are evaluated for compliance with the Kenmore Municipal Code, Kenmore Comprehensive Plan and the State Growth Management Act (GMA). Applications will be reviewed by City staff and forwarded to the City Council. The City Council will review the applications and determine which applications will be reviewed by the Planning Commission, which applications will be delayed to the next amendment cycle and which applications will not be considered. Those applications accepted for further review will be forwarded on to the Planning Commission who will hold a public hearing on the proposed amendments. The Planning Commission will then make a recommendation to the City Council, which is the final decision-making body.
