All spills must be reported.

Do not try to wash away any type of spill.

Clogging Sediment	<ul> <li>Water overflowing out of the grate, or not properly entering the grate</li> <li>Visible sediment on the street</li> <li>Construction site upstream</li> </ul>	
Thick Algae Growth	<ul> <li>Fertilizer leak or spill</li> <li>Landscaping operations</li> <li>Excessive clippings</li> <li>Potential groundwater seep</li> </ul>	
Oil	<ul> <li>Rainbow-like sheen surrounding area that sticks together when disturbed</li> <li>Fuel leak nearby</li> <li>Vehicle or machinery maintenance activities</li> </ul>	
Suds	<ul> <li>Foam-like suds,         rainbow/bubble-like sheen</li> <li>Vehicle or equipment         washing operations</li> <li>Mobile cleaning crew         dumping</li> <li>Household greywater         discharge (laundry,         dishwasher, bathtub)</li> </ul>	0 - 0 5 AM

Clogged Grease	<ul> <li>Restaurant sink drain connection to stormwater system</li> <li>Household dumping of kitchen grease</li> <li>Fatty appearance of the water</li> <li>Food truck with staining running along the ground</li> </ul>	
Sewage	<ul> <li>Foul smell, distinct cloudy-gray color of water</li> <li>Black staining inside drainage pipe</li> <li>Visible evidence of sanitary waste (toilet paper)</li> <li>Failing or leaking septic systems</li> <li>Illicit connection</li> </ul>	
Paint	<ul> <li>Large discolored spill by catch basin</li> <li>Color in catch basin and pipes downstream</li> <li>Construction/painting activities near by</li> </ul>
