The Log Boom Park Waterfront Access and Viewing project will expand the existing beach area; restore native habitat areas; create a new main trail, boat rental building, picnic shelter, and water access for hand-powered watercraft.

The Squire’s Landing Waterfront & Natural Open Space Access project will restore native habitat areas; create a public hand-powered watercraft facility with staging areas, float and hand-carry launches, a community plaza, restroom, parking lot, trails and walkways with bridges and river-viewing platforms through enhanced natural areas.
